### 2024 Year in Review

This year, The Compassionate Listening Project brought people together across divides, fostering compassion and understanding in a world where genuine connection is more needed than ever. Through 167 workshops, dialogues, and training events, we reached 762 participants from 24 countries, creating ripples of transformation that spread far and wide.

### Our Global Impact

- **Countries Represented:** Participants from Afghanistan, South Africa, Lebanon, Mexico, Palestine, Israel, Nigeria, and 17 others joined us to practice and share the transformative power of Compassionate Listening.
- **Newly Certified Facilitators:** We celebrated the certification of 13 new facilitators, including leaders from Nigeria, Malaysia, India, and the U.S., each bringing this work into their own communities.
- **Scholarships Awarded:** Over \$23,000 in scholarships supported participation from diverse voices, ensuring equity and access for those who need it most.
- **Strategic Partnerships:** We partnered with nonprofits like Tomorrow's Women, Braver Angels, and Healing Dialogue and Action, expanding our reach and impact.
